French fairy tales and folk tales were some of the first oral stories to be collected and written down, and indeed, would go on to inspire other notable storytellers, such as the Brothers Grimm. Unlike other folk tale types, French literary fairy tales were viewed as art by the upper class, and were popular in Louis XIV's court, who encouraged Charles Perrault to write these tales extensively.
